We are proud of the work we do on our clients' behalf, including these remarkable highlights:

- » New York City received \$900 million *more* in additional federal aid than they initially anticipated after Superstorm Sandy (<http://politi.co/1syClSo>) because of Hagerty's assistance.
- » Three urban areas in Texas (Austin, Dallas, and Houston), impacted by the 2015 floods over Memorial Day weekend, obtained millions of dollars in *additional* aid related to reduced insurance claims, replacement vs. repair of infrastructure, and inclusion in the Public Assistance Debris Removal Pilot Program.
- » Hagerty developed a Disaster Financial Management System to help manage \$11.0 billion in federal aid programs. After Hurricane Katrina, the Department of Housing and Urban Development recognized this system as an "exemplary practice," a rare honor.

To date there has not been a single arbitration hearing or significant adverse audit finding on any recovery project Hagerty has actively managed including 9/11, the Special Katrina Community Disaster Loan Program, and the ongoing \$12.5 billion New York City Hurricane Sandy Recovery.

- » Calculate a realistic timeframe for debris removal, and determine if participating in the Public Assistance Debris Removal Pilot Program is feasible and financially sensible.
- » Assess whether submerged infrastructure needs to be replaced instead of repaired.
- » Map out a strategy, identify priorities, and apply for improved and alternate projects.
