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WHAT IS CDBG-DR?

Federal funding for long-term disaster recovery available through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). HUD's Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) program supports a broad range of disaster recovery activities and helps communities develop housing and infrastructure programs to address long-term recovery.

CDBG-MIT

Since 2018, HUD has been allocating funds to grantees with qualifying disasters for mitigation activities. The Community Development Block Grant – Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) initiative supports implementation of strategic mitigation measures to prevent future losses.

FUNDING

Funding is available for certain major declared disasters, HUD uses data from other Federal agencies to determine unmet recovery needs and then allocates funds to states, local governments or tribes.

Helping Clients Prepare for and Recover from Disasters

Hagerty's CDBG-DR/MIT team has an extensive background in managing HUD entitlement grants and have worked on many of the largest and varied disasters from hurricanes Katrina (2005), Sandy (2012), Harvey (2017) and Ida (2021) as well as events such as the Tubbs and Camp wildfires in California in 2017 and 2018. Hagerty has supported over \$4 billion in CDBG-DR projects throughout the nation, including:

- **State of Nebraska** – Hagerty assisted the State in developing and securing approval of a CDBG-DR Action Plan for its \$108 million grant and continues to provide grants management, monitoring, and compliance services.
- **Commonwealth of Pennsylvania** – Hagerty is assisting the Commonwealth in developing a CDBG-DR Action Plan to use \$23 million in response to unmet needs arising from damage caused by Hurricane Ida.
- **Boulder County Collaborative** – Hagerty worked with local communities after the 2013 flooding in Colorado to form a collaborative partnership to assist in the management of \$63 million to include Action Plan development, program design, and grants management.
- **State of Colorado, Department of Local Affairs** – Hagerty provided monitoring and closeout services for the State's 2013 CDBG-DR program.
- **New York City** – Following Hurricane Sandy, Hagerty assisted the city in managing \$4.2 billion in CDBG-DR funding to include grants and program management as well as Action Plan and Substantial Action Plan Amendment development. Additionally, Hagerty supported the successful grant application for a \$176 million grants resulting from the National Disaster Resilience Competition.
- **State of North Carolina** – Following Hurricane Matthew, Hagerty assisted the State with action plan development as well as program implementation strategy to include program policy as well as intake processes and procedures for the State's \$230 million CDBG-DR funding.
- **State of California Housing and Community Development** – Hagerty is supporting implementation of the infrastructure program and performing tier 1 environmental reviews for the State's \$124 million CDBG-DR program. Hagerty also provided the state Unmet Needs Assessment services for the State's \$1 billion 2018 CDBG-DR program resulting from the Camp and other wildfires.
- **Montgomery County, Texas** – Hagerty is assisting the County with the implementation of their CDBG-DR \$8.9 million Home Buyout Program.
